




LOG PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS




LOG NUMBER 1:

Place log number 1 on grate such that the back sets against right tab. The left tip should set against left tab.




LOG NUMBER 2:

Place log number 2 such that back of log sets against tab. Log number 2 may touch log number 1. Indents on bottom of log number 2 should rest on grate as shown.




LOG NUMBER 3:

Place log number 3 such that bottom lies touching inside of bar number 1. Top of log number 3 should rest on flat spot of log number 1. NOTE: The side of log number 3, with light colored "split log" feature, should face front.




LOG NUMBER 4:

Place log number 4 onto tab such that "burnout" feature faces front. Log number 4 should rest on flat spot of log number 3.




LOG NUMBER 5:

Place log number 5 so that indents on bottom fits on bar 3. Front of log number 5 should rest on flat spot of log number 2.



LOG NUMBER 6:

Place log #6 such that the long, thin portion of the "Y" rests on log #1. It should rest just to the right of the raised bump on log #1. The thick end of the log should rest on the refractory and pulled forward against the right grate bar (#4).



FINAL CHECK: After starting fireplace (See Lighting Instructions) make sure logs #3 and #4 do not cross directly on top of the flames, this can lead to sooting. If they do, adjust them slightly to the left or right so that the flame comes cleanly up between them.
