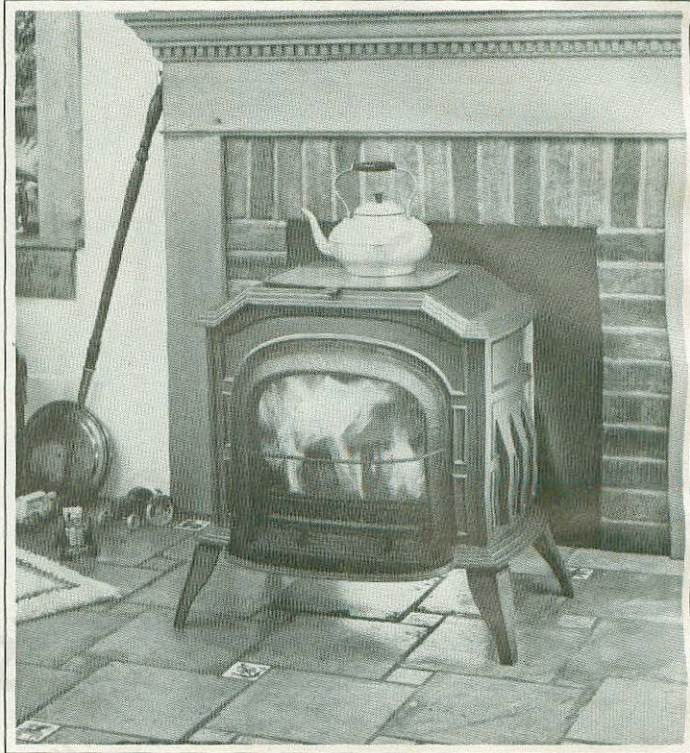

The Resolute, our newest and smallest stove, has been painstakingly engineered to allow you to make more efficient use of your fireplace. Its compact size and shape and its low flue collar height (26") make it ideally suited as a hearth stove. The front door can be removed and replaced with the handsome spark screen which comes with the stove. You'll enjoy the charm of an open fire without the wasteful inefficiency of conventional fireplace operation. Replace the front door and you have a modern, airtight heater.

The Resolute is available as a wood-burner with optional glass panels for the classic fanlight, or as a highly efficient coal-burner which will easily convert to wood.

It is the ideal stove for heating a smaller home, a cottage or that favorite family area. It is also the perfect second stove for a family which currently heats a large home with a single woodstove or a wood-fired furnace.

Utilizing the sophisticated Vermont Castings combustion engineering techniques made famous by the Defiant,

the Resolute burns in both horizontal and updraft modes and delivers preheated primary and secondary air to the critical burning areas. The preheated secondary air is mixed directly at the end of the firebox, affording a responsiveness rarely found in a stove of this size. The Resolute accepts 16-inch logs through its wide front door or the hinged top griddle. Automatic thermostatic control eliminates the need to fuss with draft controls. Steady, even heat—at the level you select—is delivered for hours on end.

The Vermont Castings dedication to the concept that beauty, efficiency and functional convenience can be combined without compromise is inherent in the Resolute's design. Like the Defiant and the Vigilant, the Resolute will enhance the decor of any room whether your taste is traditional, modern, period, or a discriminating combination. What's more, you can cook on the polished griddle or simply keep a tea kettle simmering.
